



HISPANIC ORIGIN – HAWAII, CENSUS 2000





PERCENT OF PERSONS WHO ARE ASIAN ALONE – HAWAII, (2000 U.S. CENSUS)




PERCENT OF PERSONS WHO ARE WHITE ALONE - HAWAII, (2000 U.S. CENSUS)




PERCENT OF PERSONS WHO ARE BLACK ALONE - HAWAII, (2000 U.S. CENSUS)




PERCENT OF PERSONS WHO ARE AIAN ALONE – HAWAII, (2000 U.S. CENSUS)

PERCENT OF PERSONS WHO ARE TWO OR MORE RACES – HAWAII, (2000 U.S. CENSUS)



Census 2000










