# Provider Enrollment

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## ***Providers enroll for various business reasons***

- Participation with a Health Plan or Provider Network
  - Basic enrollment data
    - e.g. Provider information, demographic, education/training, specialty, practice location, affiliations, insurance coverage and license/certifications
  - Credentialing data
    - Includes basic enrollment data plus additional data needed for verification of submitted data and provider attestations , e.g. work history, malpractice history and questions associated with this data
- Electronic Data Interchange Application
  - Includes data needed to enroll as an EDI submitter/receiver or to be associated with an existing EDI submitter/receiver
- Electronic Funds Transfer Application
  - Includes data needed to enroll to receive payments via electronic funds transfer

# ASC X12 274 Provider Information Standard

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## ***Accommodates multiple business needs***

- **Basic Enrollment Transaction**
  - Request to apply to or register with a health plan or provider network
  - Request to register for an identifier (enumeration) with a health plan, health care institution or government agency., e.g. National Provider Identifier
  - Notify a health plan, health care institution, government agency or network about updates to provider information.
  - Returns identifier assigned by the enumerator
- **Credentialing**
  - To transmit and request senders and receivers to supply data for credentialing
  - To notify trading partners that the credentialing information is verified
- **Electronic Data Interchange Application**
  - Includes data needed to enroll as an EDI submitter/receiver or to be associated with an existing EDI submitter/receiver

# ASC X12 274 Provider Information Standard

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## ***Accommodates multiple business needs***

- Electronic Funds Transfer Application
  - Includes data needed to enroll to receive payments via electronic funds transfer
- Provider Directory
  - Transfers network or affiliated provider information
- Electronic Service Information Discovery
  - Query and Response to obtain Electronic Service Information (ESI), including electronic address and security information to facilitate secure exchange of health information
  - ONC Standards & Interoperability Framework initiative

# ASC X12 274 Provider Information Standard

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## *A Viable Standard:*

- Identifies data content needed for Provider enrollment
  - Basic enrollment/registration
  - EDI enrollment
  - EFT enrollment
- Supports all Providers and their relationships
  - Individuals
  - Groups of Individuals
  - Institutions
  - NPI eligible and Atypical
- Utilizes existing EDI infrastructures
- XML Schema available

# ASC X12 274 Provider Information Standard

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## *A Viable Standard:*

- Electronic File Interchange for NPPES
  - Bulk enumeration
  - XML Schema based on the ASC X12N Health Care Provider Information (X253)
  - Implementation Guide updated using ASC X12's expedited processes
    - To accommodate business need gaps identified working in concert with CMS
    - To meet CMS timeframes for making the EFI process available
- NCPDP
  - Is an Electronic File Interchange Organization (EFIO)
    - Uses this process to submit bulk applications to NPPES for NPIs for their constituents
  - Has formed a task group to address pharmacy provider enrollment

# ASC X12 274 Provider Information Standard

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## *External Code Sources Used*

- Health Care Provider Taxonomy code set
  - Originally developed by ASC X12 and CMS
  - Turned over to NUCC in 2001
  - Consistent with health care specialty code set used in other transactions mandated under HIPAA and the NPPES
- Provider Characteristics
  - Originally developed by ASC X12
  - Turned over to NUCC a few years after taxonomy
  - For additional data needed for enrollment or credentialing purposes
  - Provides flexibility for additional data needs identified to collect for provider enrollment purposes

# ASC X12 Provider Information Standard

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## *Next Steps*

- ASC X12 will:
  - Update existing implementations as needed to meet new business needs
  - Complete development of S&I Framework Electronic Service Information Discovery implementation
  - Create implementation for EFT enrollment
  - Support piloting of implementations within the industry to insure business needs are met
