- Purpose
 - Improve community well-being through support for multi-sector collaboration at the neighborhood level.
- Value of a core set of cross cutting domains
 - Provide a common language
 - Help communities assess where they are
 - Help different sectors see where to focus for collective impact

- Critical need for data at the neighborhood level (sub county)
 - Provide tools to use American Community Survey (ACS)
 - Make better use of Vitals
- Opportunity for greater collaboration across federal agencies and programs
- Need for an environmental scan to understand how other sectors are approaching care domains

Challenges:

- Achieving parsimony while including key sectors
- Meeting other sectors where they are
- Focusing on determinants AND equity AND life course
- Supporting assessment (comparative) AND local action

Convene & seek input from users (communities)	5
Conduct pilots, community testing, gather case studies	5
Be more clear on purpose and use	4
Make data available in one place (Data Portal) with tools (e.g., visualization)	3
Make Census ACS data more accessible/usable	3
Encourage cross Agency (Federal and States) collaboration	3
